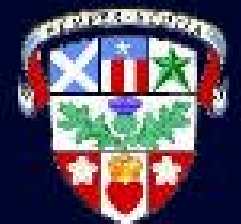

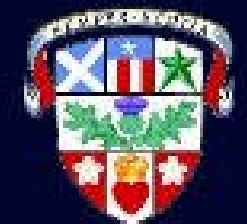

The American-Scottish Foundation is the pre-eminent, US-based, national not-for-profit Scottish-American membership organization

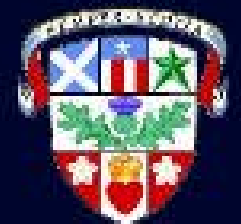

- Current Patron is His Grace Alexander Douglas-Hamilton, 16th Duke of Hamilton, 13th Duke of Brandon

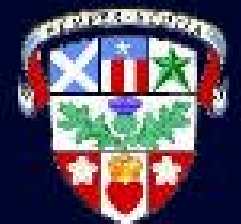


With his wife and children, the Duke continues to live in and maintain the ancestral family home, Lennoxlove, outside Edinburgh, Scotland.



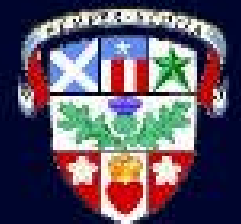
Our Mission

- Philanthropic, social, cultural & educational activities



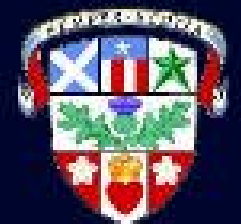
Bursary and Education Programs

- Enabling school groups, dance groups and performers to travel to Scottish festivals or come to NYC



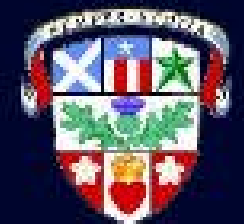
Community: The ARCHIE Foundation

- ARCHIE brought 50 runners to the 2011 New York Marathon, and aims to bring over 100 runners in 2013



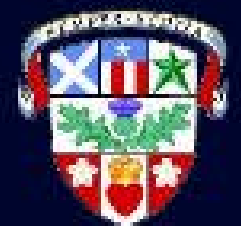
Community Development with the SCF

- Toy Library, Edinburgh and other initiatives



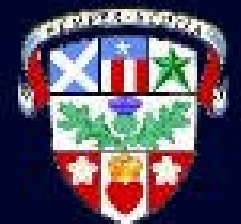
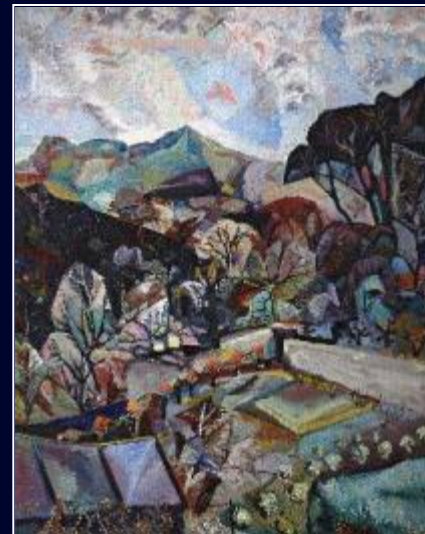
ASF: A Bridge to Business

- ASF Energy Forum 2013 - April 5th. “Our Energy Future: The Power of Partnerships in Scotland and America”



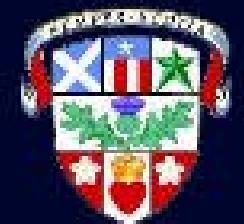
A Bridge for Scotland in the Arts

- Increasing awareness, showcasing Scotland's artists



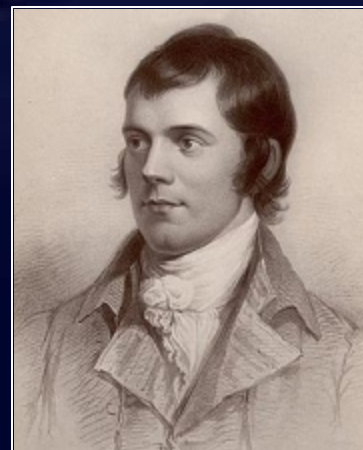
A Bridge for Scotland in the Arts
